Core Program

Small Actions Made a Big Impact

The Rho II Leadership in Action projects adapted to a new two-step model inspired by social change theory.

Class Members formed individual Social Contracts, committing to one tangible impact in a short period of time. As teams formed they explored common themes connecting each commitment, and found inspiration

for their team projects.

Their impact ranged from increasing parent involvement in Pawtucket schools, collecting critical basic resources, including nearly 300 pillowcases, for Crossroads RI, and forming a strategic vision of community-centered programming at the developing 25 Bough Street.

College Program

Developed Life Changing Connections

During a College Leadership Rhode Island session day focused on nonprofits and service, TsheWang Sherpa CLRI '20, was so inspired by Laura Jaworski '18, executive director of House of Hope, he successfully sought a seat on House of Hope's board.

Seven months into a post-graduation job search during the peak of the pandemic, one factor helped him stand apart from his competition according to the company that hired him: his service on a governing board.

LRI pioneered the inaugural Statewide Scavenger Hunt, sending hundreds of Rhode Islanders out to every corner of the state.

Guided by a custom map designed by a local illustrator, participants re-discovered Rhode Island's history, culture, and landmarks by way of real-world locations and a unique phone-based augmented reality experience.

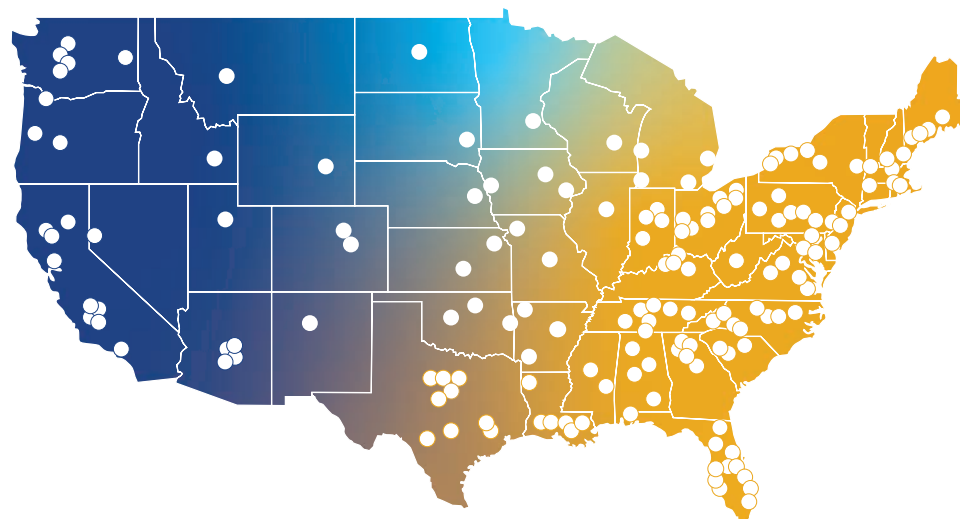
National Leadership Network



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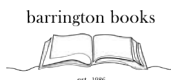
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
